

Spring 2000 Grants

SAT Software (\$800)

Ellen Davies (ZCHS)

This grant will allow high school students to have access to PowerPrep, an interactive SAT/ACT preparation software package that can be used at school or at home.

Rosie Reading (\$480)

Jane Bewley (ZCHS)

This grant funded the purchase of six copies of 20 paperback book titles nominated for the Eliot Rosewater Indiana High School Book Award.

Collaborative Literature (\$780)

Andy Seward (ZLMS)

This grant funded the purchase of sets of books to be used in literature classes that will facilitate small group discussions between five or six students who have read the same book.

ZUMS Teaming Retreat (\$250)

Sean Conner (ZUMS)

This grant provided partial funding for ZUMS staff to attend an overnight retreat in a state park lodge to attend workshops on applying the teaming process to the practice of course and unit development.
