Bagels and Books (\$540)

Deb Brooks (Eagle Elementary)

This grant allowed Eagle Elementary third grade students to expand their creative and expository writing skills by creating original stories, puzzles, and game boards to accompany their specialty projects.

Buddy Bags (\$357)

Jonann Bredekamp (PVLE)

This grant enhanced reading and writing for students at PVLE by providing "Buddy Bags" to take home. The "Buddy Bags" had themes and activities that encouraged involvement.
