Shoulder Arm Back Development (\$2035)

Tammy Nowakowski (PVLE & PVUE)

This grant funded purchase of equipment for the game "SHARBADE." This game is played on specially designed scooter boards for PE classes.

Promoting Academic Excellence Through Interactive Technology (\$1500)

Monica Plantan (ZMS)

This grant funded purchase of "Smart Boards" for the classroom. This takes the place of the more traditional overhead projector. SMART Boards can be used in all aspects of teaching and demonstration.

Exploring Traditional and Contemporary Requiems and Preparing for Performance at Carnegie Hall (\$1,000)
